## By-Laws AND REGULATIONS

## ADOPTED BY The Commissioners of Trappe.

No. 1- Be it enacted, That no person or persons shall be permitted to ride or drive any animal upon the streets of the Town at a speed of more than eight miles per hour, and any person violating this act shall be fined the sum of one dollar for each offense.

No. 2- Be it enacted, That if any person shall ride or drive any animal upon the sidewalks of said Town, or trespass thereon with any vehicle, or obstruct the same to the inconvenience of the inhabitants, he, she or they shall be fined the sum of Twenty-five cents for each offense and held responsible for the full amount of damage done by his, her or their act.

No. 3- No Stallion or Jack shall be paraded on the streets of the Town, or exhibited within its limits, except within a stable, and for every offense against this law, the owner or owners of the horse or jack shall be fined One dollar.

No. 4- No swine shall be permitted to run at large in the streets of the Town, under a penalty of Fifty cents for each hog, shoat or pig so trespassing. The owner or owners shall be responsible for all damages or charges accruing till said fine shall have been paid. The Bailiff shall give ten days public notice of such violation, and if the property is not called for, it shall be disposed of at Public sale, to satisfy all fines, damages and charges.

No. 5- Assemblies shall not congregate within the Town on Sabbath day for tumult and noise, and at no time shall wrestling, boxing, dancing or gaming be permitted publicly within its limits.

Sec. 2 Any person or persons who shall violate the provisions of this act shall pay a fine of Fifty cents for each offense.

No. 6- Be it enacted, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to discharge any firearms within the limits of the Town, or to fire shooting crackers, or other fireworks under a penalty of one dollar for every violation.

No. 7- That all nuisances shall be subject to fine, the nuisance and the fine to be at the discretion of the Commissioners. The fine shall not exceed five dollars in any one case.

No. 8- Be it enacted, That no Cow, male, steer, heifer or calf shall be permitted to run at large in the streets of Trappe under a penalty of Twenty five cents for each cow, heifer, male, steer or calf, and the owner or owners of such animals so trespassing on said streets shall be responsible for such damages and charges until said fine and damages shall have been paid. The officer shall give ten days notice of such violation, and if property be not called for, it shall be sold at Public Auction to pay for damages and costs.

No. 9- No Geese shall run at large in the streets of Trappe, and a fine of Ten cents a head shall be paid for every violation of this Law.

No. 10- Any steam engine, propelled by steam, shall not be allowed to stop in the streets of Trappe or the limits thereof (except as provided for in the state law). Any one violating this law shall be fined a sum not less than Five dollars and costs, and not over Twenty dollars for each offense.
